Motions to Dismiss or Reconvert

When the Trustee's office files a Motion to Dismiss or Reconvert for various reasons, i.e. failure to pay, material default, failure to appear at a 341 Meeting of Creditors, failure to timely complete, etc., it is served with a 21 day all party notice. If no response is filed, the Trustee's office will file an Order Dismissing or Reconverting the Case. If a response is filed, the Trustee's office will set the Motion for a hearing. At the hearing, the case will either be dismissed, reconverted or some type of an Agreed Order will be filed allowing for special provisions that will satisfy the concerns of the Motion.
